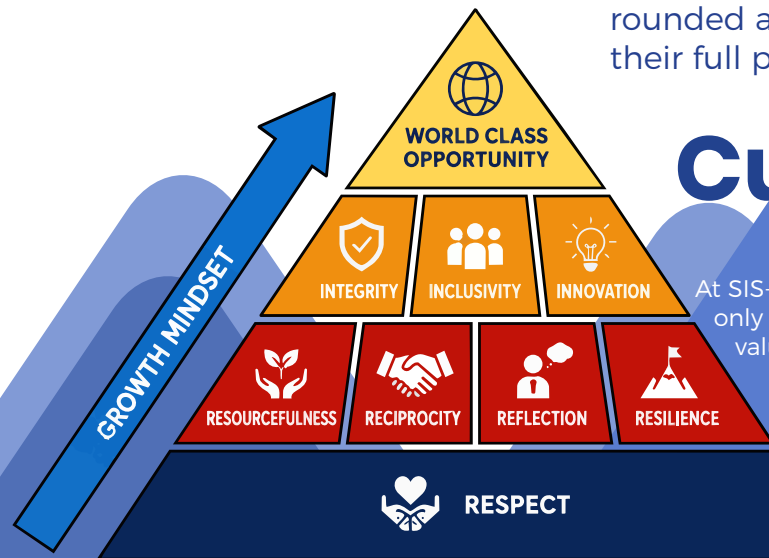

Our Preschool Curriculum

At SIS-PIK, our Preschool Curriculum combines the fundamental elements of the Singaporean Nurturing Early Learners Framework, the Cambridge Early Years Programme and our STEAM approach, creating a purposeful, play-based learning experience for every child.



In **Nursery**, children build foundational social, emotional and communication skills as they discover school life, make new friends and begin learning in **English, Chinese and Bahasa Indonesia** through songs, rhymes, conversation and play.



In **K1 and K2**, children build their language, motor, social-emotional and early mathematical skills through engaging experiences including circle time, water play, gym, library and purposeful play. **Project Work and STEAM experiences** encourage children to explore, question, create and develop early critical-thinking skills.

Our K2 Transition Programme supports children as they prepare for Grade 1, gaining confidence and familiarity with the Primary school environment.



Our Primary Curriculum

At SIS-PIK, our Primary Curriculum provides a holistic education that develops each student's academic potential, confidence and character. We build on the strengths of the Singapore Curriculum, complemented by a carefully designed non-core curriculum that provides a well-rounded learning experience.

As a trilingual school, we place strong emphasis on developing language proficiency in English, Chinese (Mandarin) and Bahasa Indonesia. Students build their skills from phonics/Pinyin and expansion of vocabulary through to comprehension and understanding a range of texts. Students who require support in any language are offered participation in the second language programmes or intervention support for English.

In Mathematics, students follow the Singapore approach, including Concrete-Pictorial-Abstract (CPA) and Model Drawing, developing strong conceptual understanding and problem-solving skills. In Science, students develop process skills through inquiry-based learning, encouraging them to question, investigate and make connections.

Beyond the core curriculum, students experience Dance & Drama, Visual Arts, IT, Virtual Reality, Robotics and STEAM Project Work, supported by our specialist facilities and student-centred approach to learning. Our goal is simple: to equip every student with the knowledge, skills and confidence to thrive.



iPSLE

SIS-PIK is appointed by the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB) as an authorised examination centre for the Singapore International Primary School Examination (iPSLE). We are proud to be one of only three schools in Indonesia offering the iPSLE.

The iPSLE is the international version of Singapore's Primary School Leaving Examination (PSLE) and provides an internationally recognised benchmark of achievement against the educational standards of the Singapore Primary Education system.

Renowned for its strong academic foundations. Particularly in Mathematics and Science, the Singapore education system provides a rigorous framework for learning. At SIS-PIK, students are prepared to sit the iPSLE at the end of Primary/Grade 6 in English Language, Mathematics, Science and Chinese Language.

Our Junior High Curriculum

Grades 7 & 8

Our Junior High provision is truly world-class, incorporating the very best of international curricula (Cambridge and Singaporean) with our own unique learning programme. Our two-year course provides a well-rounded curriculum which equips students with the essential knowledge and skills needed for future IGCSE study, while also exposing them to innovative subjects essential for success in the 21st century.

Junior High School

IGCSE & BTEC Curriculum

In Grade 9, our students begin a two-year programme of study exclusive to SIS-PIK. We are the only school in Jakarta where Junior High students enrol to study the internationally recognised qualifications of both Cambridge IGCSE and Pearson BTEC.

Cambridge IGCSE

The Cambridge IGCSE is a knowledge-rich programme providing students with a broad range of studies across eight subjects of their choice. Cambridge IGCSE qualifications are highly regarded by universities in student reports and transcripts, providing a strong foundation of knowledge and skills for successful progression to the IBDP in Grade 11. The final IGCSE assessment period consists of formal examinations in Term 4 of Grade 10, testing the full two-year curriculum.



In most cases, students choose eight subjects from a wide range, which can include:

- **Languages (students may take three):** First Language English, English as a Second Language, Foreign Language Mandarin, Chinese as a Second Language, Bahasa Indonesia
- **Humanities:** Global Perspectives, Geography, English Literature
- **Sciences:** Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Computer Science
- **Mathematics:** Extended Mathematics, Additional Mathematics
- **Professional, Vocational, and Creative Subjects:** Music, Business Studies, Economics

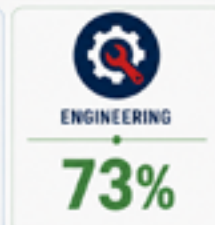

The Grade 10 Programme

(For New Entrants into Grade 10)

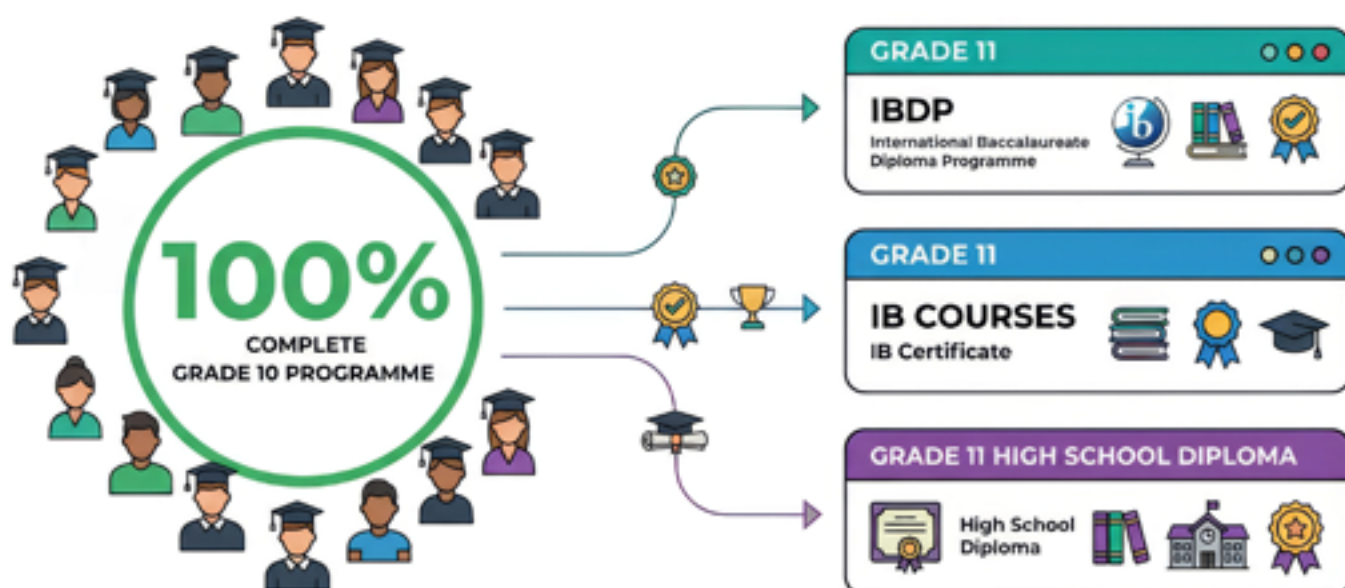
We understand that students come to us from different educational backgrounds, so we have created a programme to suit students who join us after completing Junior High (Grades 7-9) elsewhere. Our unique Grade 10 Programme provides a broad and balanced education offering up to seven qualifications in one year. All of our students who have completed our Grade 10 programme have successfully progressed to one of our Grade 11 & 12 pathways for university preparation.



We also recognise that each child joining our Grade 10 Programme has different needs. This programme offers a personalised timetable that may include small-group or one-to-one support for students with varying levels of language proficiency.

Students will study:

- **IGCSE English Language**
- **IGCSE Bahasa Indonesia and/or IGCSE Chinese Mandarin**
- **IGCSE Mathematics**
- **BTEC Applied Science (Chemistry, Physics and Biology)**
- **BTEC Performing Arts**
- **BTEC Business Studies**



Senior High School

The International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

It is our vision to provide students with a world-class education. The IBDP is internationally recognised and defined by leading universities as the 'best qualification, providing students with the skills they need to thrive in higher education.' Research also suggests that students who complete the IBDP programme are more likely than others to complete their undergraduate degrees, pursue graduate work, and be engaged in various aspects of university life.

The IBDP is unique in preparing students for the future. It develops students with an excellent breadth and depth of knowledge, who flourish physically, intellectually, and ethically, can speak at least two languages, excel in traditional subjects, and explore critical thinking through the programme's unique Theory of Knowledge course.

Students following our IBDP pathway take six separate subjects (three at Standard Level and three at Higher Level). They additionally take core subjects in CAS, TOK, and EE.

Students choose six subjects from a choice typically including:

English, Chinese, Bahasa Indonesia, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Computer Science, Economics, Business Management, Psychology, Maths: Applications & Interpretations, Maths: Analysis & Approaches, and Film.

Core Subjects:

Students complete all three of the following core areas:

- **CAS (Creativity, Activity, Service)**

Students complete projects to develop creative thinking and healthy living, and complete volunteer projects to develop leadership, collaboration and problem-solving.

- **EE (Extended Essay)**

Students complete an independent, self-directed piece of research, finishing with a 4,000-word paper. This develops outstanding research and analytical writing skills for university preparation.

- **TOK (Theory of Knowledge)**

In a world of AI and information overload, the IBDP Theory of Knowledge curriculum teaches students not just what to think, but how to question, evaluate and think for themselves. Students complete a 1,600-word essay and presentation; an excellent preparation for further university studies.



IBDP subjects are assessed through international assessment projects and formal examinations in Term 4 of Grade 12. IBDP subjects are graded on a scale from 1 -7, with 7 being the highest award available for each subject.

SIS-PIK High School Diploma Incorporating International Baccalaureate Courses and the International BTEC Programme

Our High School Diploma provides students with a wide selection of internationally accredited qualifications. Graduates have secured first choice university placements all over the world.

Students can choose up to six subjects from a range of IB Courses and Level 3 Pearson BTEC International Qualifications



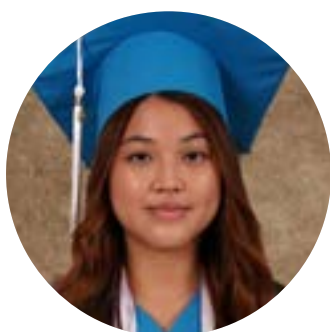
BTEC Level 3 qualifications all focus on industry and business, highly practical and assessed through assignments verified by Pearson UK, the world's largest education provider.

BTECs are graded as Distinction*, Distinction, Merit and Pass.

A standard requirement for entry to international universities would be three BTEC Subsidiary Diplomas. **The UK Universities and Colleges Admissions Service (UCAS) recognises that achieving the highest score in a BTEC Subsidiary Diploma (D*) is equivalent to obtaining a top grade in an IB Higher Level subject or A Level.**

Life Skills & Character Development

Students leave SIS-PIK with more than just good grades. They leave as respectful, caring and well-rounded individuals, ready to contribute to and improve the world around them.

We place a strong emphasis on teaching essential life skills to ensure our students are well-prepared for the future. Our comprehensive life skills programme, from Preschool to High School, equips students with vital abilities for social integration, self-care, and value-driven decision-making. Through interactive lessons and real-world applications, children learn to navigate social situations with confidence, take responsibility for their well-being, and uphold values which include our 4Rs - Resourcefulness, Reciprocity, Reflection and Resilience. These skills are integral to their personal development and success in an ever-changing world.



University & Careers Guidance

Ms Cilly, our dedicated University Guidance Counsellor, plays a pivotal role in helping SIS-PIK students gain entrance to the world's top 100 universities, which is especially impressive considering there are over 30,000 universities globally. Through weekly group and 1-to-1 sessions, she provides expert advice on university admissions and scholarship opportunities. Our students have been accepted into prestigious institutions such as Imperial College, London (ranked 2nd globally), and the National University of Singapore (ranked 8th globally). Whether aspiring to become medics, engineers, business leaders, or artists, SIS-PIK Careers and University guidance is their pathway to success.

Students are supported with subject choice selection, university applications and building their own personal learning profile.

Student Support @ SIS-PIK

Emotional & Physical Wellbeing

At SIS-PIK, we believe that a happy child is a successful child. Our approach to pastoral care and support is designed to nurture the emotional, physical, and social well-being of every student. We recognise that a safe and supportive environment is essential for academic success and personal growth, and we are committed to providing the resources and guidance necessary to help each student thrive. We have a dedicated team of counsellors and educational specialists in our Student Support Department.



Our **Emotional and Wellbeing Counsellor**, Ms Levana, plays a crucial role in supporting students during times of need. As an Educational Psychologist, she offers expert guidance for students who may be experiencing anxiety or require strategies to enhance their well-being or academic performance. Ms. Levana is also equipped to organise diagnostic testing for students who need additional academic support, working closely with our teachers to implement the necessary interventions to ensure each student's success.

We are also proud to have **a team of qualified nurses** available throughout the school day to care for students who may feel unwell or need assistance with medication or managing chronic conditions. Our sick bay is well-equipped, and we maintain direct links with the local hospital, ensuring swift and effective medical support when needed. Additionally, visiting practitioners provide valuable services such as dental health demonstrations and vaccinations.



To further support our students, our High School is organised with a team of **Heads of Year**, who are responsible for the well-being and progress of each year group. They work closely with Form Teachers and serve as the primary point of contact for parents, ensuring seamless communication and coordination with other support systems, such as our school counsellor. In the Primary School, a dedicated **Pupil Development Coordinator** oversees the pastoral care of our younger students, ensuring they receive the guidance and support they need as they grow.

Student Support @ SIS-PIK

Mentoring, intervention and support from Nursery to Grade 12

At SIS-PIK we believe every student has the potential to succeed and deserves the opportunity to thrive. No two students are the same, which is why we create small class sizes to know and respond to the unique needs of each child.

Every child brings their own strengths, interests and talents alongside areas where they can continue to grow. All children have incredible potential. Our teachers and staff provide personalised support to help students build confidence, develop effective learning habits and achieve their full potential - whether they are developing their language skills, self-management or extending their learning further.

K2 Readiness Test

As children transition from Kindergarten into Primary School, we use the K2 Readiness Test to understand each student's developing skills in numeracy, language and sensory perception, helping us plan a smooth and well-supported transition into Grade 1.



Our **Primary School** provides supplementary learning opportunities for students who benefit from additional support. These small-group sessions are tailored to specific areas of learning and enable students to build confidence, strengthen key skills and continue to make progress.

In **High School**, we use baseline testing from the Cambridge University Centre for Evaluation and Monitoring (CEM) to support our identification of the specific support our students need. This support can include additional support classes, academic mentoring or inclusion within our Peak Language Programme.

Our High School curriculum includes additional small-group lessons called 'The Climb', where students attend classes tailored to their specific needs. These classes may offer additional support in a particular subject area, high-level extension work that goes above and beyond the normal curriculum, or the opportunity to explore a new subject area such as Psychology or Creative Media.

Additional Language Support

As a trilingual school, we recognise that all of our students have varying levels of proficiency in each of our taught languages: English, Bahasa Indonesia and Mandarin Chinese. We offer a range of programmes to support students who are new to a language, need additional help, or are ready to be challenged to the highest level. Our support includes:

- small-group classes for those new to Bahasa Indonesia.
- the setting of Mandarin Chinese classes by current level.
- an extensive programme of English as an Additional language support including one-to-one tuition, small-group intervention classes and academic mentoring, led by our EAL Coordinator and a team of specialist language teachers.

Additionally, students are placed with an appropriate language form teacher who can mentor and guide them in their most proficient language.



SEND Support

Every child has differing strengths and areas where they may need additional support. At SIS-PIK, we believe every child deserves the opportunity to thrive academically. Our dedicated Special Educational Needs coordinator works closely with our Educational Psychologist, Wellbeing Counsellor, and teachers to support students with diverse learning needs. With training in the latest evidence-based strategies, our staff ensure that all students are guided to reach their full potential in a caring, positive and aspirational environment.

Co-Curricular Activities @ SIS-PIK

At SIS-PIK, we believe a truly rounded curriculum is essential to student success. Co-curricular activities (CCAs) are not an 'extra' to the curriculum - they are a vital part of it. 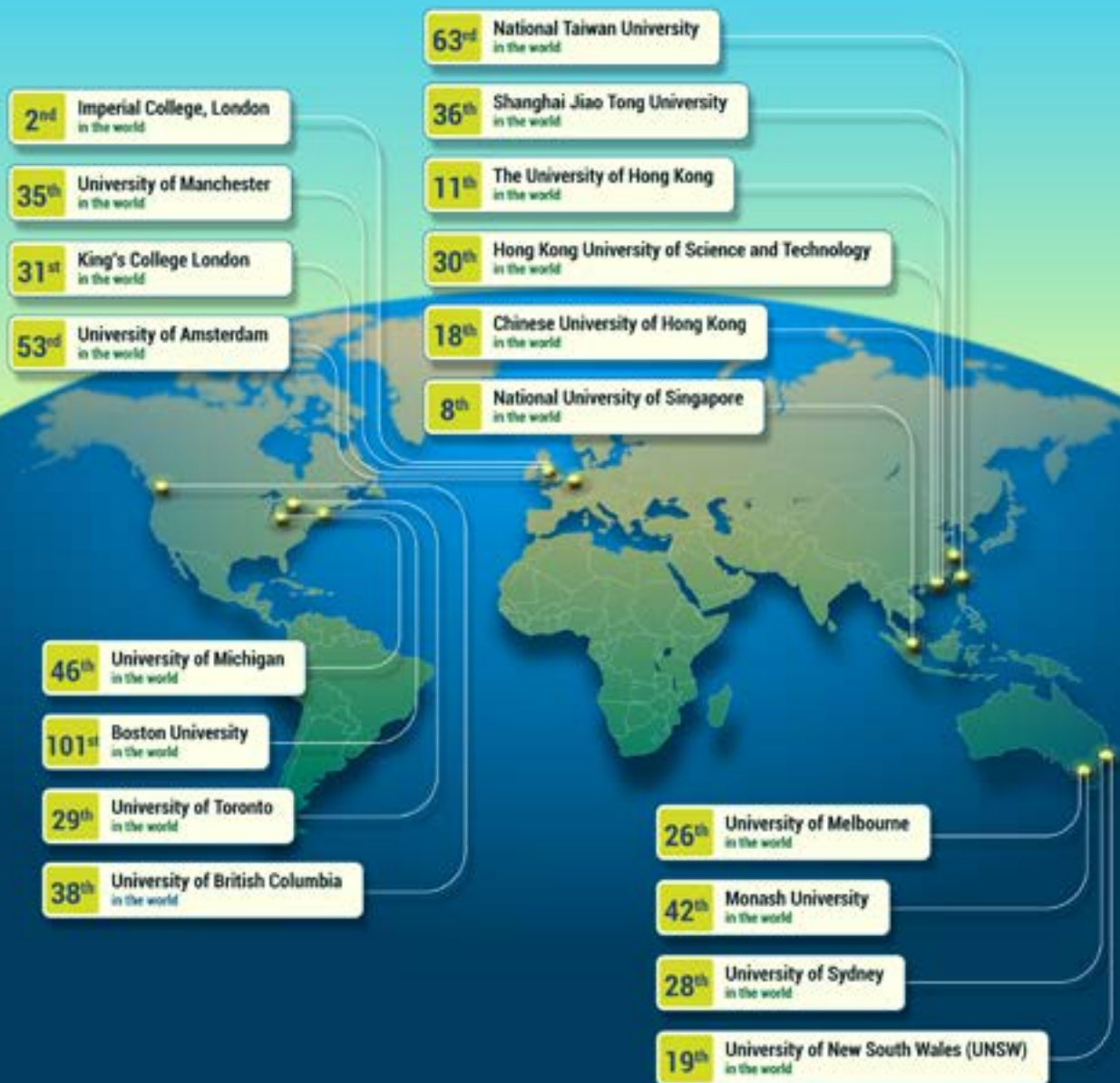
SISWa Cares is an independent charity run by our students. For many years, students have planned and led projects that support communities both locally and across Indonesia. Their work has included providing urgent supplies to communities affected by the Cianjur earthquake and travelling to Kupang to help build new classrooms for a village school. The work of SISWa Cares takes many forms.
